Created in 1997, the FBC Foundation has a heart for missions – whether around the corner or across the globe. This non-profit, public foundation is sponsored by the members of First Baptist Church (FBC) of Huntsville, Alabama, as a vehicle to share the love of Christ. Through direct contributions or philanthropic estate giving, the Foundation supports mission trips – both foreign and domestic – student scholarship grants for ministry education, FBC capital improvements/maintenance, and ministerial residency positions at FBC.

WHAT IT SUPPORTS

All Foundation funds designated for mission work support FBC members in mission opportunities. Mission activities vary from preaching, teaching, personal witnessing, and home visitation to medical ministries, clothing, food, construction, and more. Sometimes, monies even help purchase land to plant new churches in the mission field.

GIVE SOMETHING BACK

If you're more interested in giving than going, there are several ways you can financially support FBC Foundation activities.

- **Direct Contributions** – The Foundation welcomes any direct contributions of cash, stocks or bonds at any time. Many have found that a contribution to the Foundation is an excellent way to honor the memory of a loved one, or recognize a special person or group.
- **Inheritance Gifts** – Bequests may be made for a fixed dollar amount, a percentage of an estate, or specific stocks and bonds.
- **Gifts of Life Insurance** – You can opt to purchase a new policy or donate an existing policy that has outlived its original purpose. Life insurance has become one of the most popular ways to contribute substantial sums for a relatively small investment.
- **Other Gifts** – There are various other plans of acceptable giving, such as the creation of special trusts or annuities.
